ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 73476 in Case No. 8585 ordered respondent to pay a \$5,000 punitive fine; Decision No. 73917 permitted the fine to be paid in monthly installments of \$150. Respondent to date has made monthly payments totalling \$3,900 leaving a balance of \$1,100. Respondent requests deferment in paying the balance because of financial difficulty. The Commission staff has investigated the matter and has no objections to the request.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that respondent may pay the balance of \$1,100 in payments of \$150 or more monthly starting July 1, 1971.
