ORDER

Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial drill and an industrial spur track at grade across Junction Avenue in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DA-47.25-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by three Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), augmented with additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track, shall provide a

reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 2" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that the companies to be served are in need of immediate service. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
