TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

STOL Air, Inc., applicant herein, has applied for authority to conduct passenger air carrier and freight operations between sites at San Francisco and Sacramento. It appears that STOL Air, Inc., may in fact be conducting such passenger air carrier operations between San Francisco and Sacramento without any authority from this Commission, as required by the provisions of the Passenger Air Carriers' Act (Sections 2739, et seq. of the Public Utilities Code). Good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that STOL Air, Inc., applicant herein, refrain from conducting passenger air carrier operations between points in San Francisco and points in Sacramento, or between any points within California, pending disposition of this application or further order of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to make service of this order upon STOL Air, Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be the date of service upon STOL Air, Inc.
