SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 77698 dated September 1, 1970, in Application No. 52066 authorized City Transfer, Inc., to purchase and acquire from Certified Freight Lines, Inc., certain certificated rights authorizing operations as a highway common carrier.

By Application No. 52066 City Transfer, Inc., also sought authority to increase rates. Applicant proposes to cancel alternative rail rates now published in Certified Freight Lines, Inc., tariffs. Increases stem from traffic which now moves on alternative rail rates becoming subject to class rates.

The class rates in question are generally on the level of the rates which the Commission in its minimum rate orders has prescribed as the minimum rates to be observed by highway carriers. After consideration, the Commission finds that the increases which will result from City Transfer, Inc., adopting the tariffs (except the rail alternative rates) of Certified Freight Lines, Inc., are justified. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the sought rate increase authority should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that, in exercising the authority granted by Decision No. 77698, City Transfer, Inc., may increase rates to the extent necessary to amend or reissue the tariffs on file (except the rail alternative rates) naming rates and rules governing the common carrier operations herein to show that it has adopted as its own said rates and rules (except the rail alternative rates).

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
