State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a Frontage Road at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. A-94.1-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No.72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of six feet from the rail on both sides of the track, shall provide reasonable regular surface with gradual slope but not to exceed 1"

vertical to 3" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 113.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
