Application of THE COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ,
a political subdivision of the State of
California, for permission to construct
a new highway overpass over the railroad
tracks of the Southern Pacific Trans-
portation Company, Olympia Branch, at a
place approximately two hundred feet
(200') northerly of the existing old
Zayante Road Railroad (Crossing EC 128.0)

O R D E R

The County of Santa Cruz is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of New Mount Hermon Road over the track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company, near Felton, Santa Cruz County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. EC-128.1-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Transportation Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 120 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years

unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.
The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the
date hereof.
