OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission's Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (ERT 1) contains, in Sections 2-B and 2-C thereof, various interim exception ratings which apply in lieu of those named in National Motor Freight Classification A-11, and govern various minimum rate tariffs making specific reference thereto. These exception ratings are subject to an expiration date of December 31, 1970. By the above petition, as amended, California Trucking Association requests that the expiration date be extended to December 31, 1971, in connection with some of the involved ratings.

Petitioner seeks to extend the expiration date governing the exception ratings in Section 2-B of ERT 1 on commodities that move in sufficient volume and are of a nature which justify temporary retention thereof. The involved ratings include, where appropriate, revision of the minimum weights to reflect California ladings. Petitioner also proposes to extend the expiration date governing the exception ratings in Section 2-C of ERT 1 on those items on which proposals have been submitted to the National Classification Board but not yet disposed of by that board.

Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 5, 9-B and 19.

The proposed expiration date would govern the ratings set forth in Revised Exhibits A and B of First Amendment to the petition as further amended by Second Amendment thereto.

Petitioner states that the ratings in Section 2-B of ERT 1 are the "old rail-oriented B, C, D and E" ratings which applied prior to the adoption of the truck-oriented classification and that the ratings in Section 2-C thereof represent items which are or were pending before the National Classification Board. Petitioner alleges that these ratings were retained on an interim basis to (1) minimize the impact of the classification changeover upon shippers; (2) allow the parties adequate time to evaluate and adjust shipping and marketing practices; and (3) permit final disposition of certain items pending before the National Classification Board.

Petitioner avers that a survey was conducted for the purpose of determining (1) whether the shipper originally requesting retention of a particular exception rating in Section 2-B still wished it retained; and (2) if so, what were some of the characteristics and conditions of transportation which would support continuance of the rating for an additional period beyond December 31, 1970. Petitioner declares that its proposal reflects the results of this survey and would provide interested parties with adequate time to dispose of the exception ratings that are to be retained.

Copies of the petitions and amendments thereto were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations, carrier representatives and other interested parties on or about July 29, October 8 and 14, 1970. The petition and amendments were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 31, October 13 and 16, 1970. No objection to the granting of the petition, as amended, has been received.

C. 7858 (Pet. 80) - ams Commission staff analysis of petitioner's proposal discloses that certain exception ratings, which move little or no traffic or are no longer required, will be allowed to expire on December 31, 1970. The remaining exception ratings would continue in effect for another year and the minimum weights governing certain of the commodities in question would be increased to reflect more adequately the carrying capacities of the carriers' equipment. Extension of the expiration date, as proposed, would afford interested parties with sufficient time to deal with the remaining exception ratings. The staff recommends that the petition, as amended, be granted by ex parte order. In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that extension of the expiration date governing the exception ratings in question is reasonable and increases in the minimum rates and charges, which may result on the expiration date of such exception ratings, are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition, as amended, should be granted. IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 1, 1971, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof. 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 66195, as amended, be and they are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered herein. -3-

- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than January 1, 1971; tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty-four days after the date hereof.
