The City of Redlands is hereby authorized to construct Citrus Avenue at grade across a track of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BP-546.7-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (General Order No. 72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossings signs (General Order No. 75-B), reflectorized with zeflex-zeflective sheet material.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne by applicant.

Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track, shall provide a

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reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the crossing signs which will impair the motorists' view.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
