SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Bay Center Warehouse Co., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at San Jose.

Roy R. Williams, attorney for the warehouseman, has submitted to this Commission amended Articles of Incorporation changing the corporate name of the company to Overmyer of San Jose. Accordingly, the operative right will be amended to show the new corporate name. The warehouseman will also be ordered to amend its tariff pursuant to General Order No. 61-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 74103 in Application No. 50114 is amended by substituting therein "Overmyer of San Jose" in place and stead of "Bay Center Warehouse Co.".


2. Decision No. 74103 in Application No. 50114 is further amended by incorporating therein Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.


3. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Overmyer of San Jose shall amend its tariff on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.2 of General Order No. 61-A.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 74103 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
