OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78026 entered today in Case No. 5435,

Petition for Modification No. 144, et al., established revised tariff provisions governing the use of hourly rates in connection with alternatively applied common carrier rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 19, and found that comparable amendments should also be made in the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B. Said decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 24, 1971, First Revised Page 46, attached hereto / and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are also subject to Decision No. 67766, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than January 24, 1971.
- 4. In all other respects said Decision No. 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.

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SECTION 3

EQUIPMENT RATES AND RULES

Rates in this section apply only when, prior to the transportation of the property, the shipper enters into a written agreement with the carrier as provided in Item 500. (See Exception in paragraph (d) of Item 500.) When such agreement is executed, rates in Section 2 will not apply.

*Rates in this section shall not be combined with alternatively applied common carrier rates to develop through rates for transportation between points within this drayage area, nor between points within this drayage area and points outside this drayage area.
