ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 56753, dated May 27, 1958, Don Diego Charter Bus, Inc., a corporation, was authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of persons between certain points in the Cities of San Diego and La Mesa, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Coliseum, City of Los Angeles, on the other hand, only on days when the Los Angeles Dodgers were playing in Coliseum.

The Los Angeles Dodgers have transferred operations from the Coliseum to Dodger's Stadium sometime ago and the above-mentioned service has not been operated since that time.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights created by Decision No. 56753 in Application No. 39860 are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Don Diego Charter Bus, Inc. are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such mailing.
