SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78062 entered today in Case No. 5432

(Petition for Modification No. 608) et al., authorized amendment of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5 and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 in connection with certain exception ratings on flavored or phosphated beverages, prepared dough, oil, water or gas well outfits or supplies and salt. The decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be amended by separate order in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 1, 1971, Fifth Revised Page 27 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
