SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 6 of Decision No. 77211 dated May 12, 1970 provides that upon the submission of a written plan of programmed main flushing and the resolution of service problems in the Deerfield Road-Burke Lane service area applicant would be authorized by supplemental order to file the Appendix B rates attached to the decision.

By letter dated July 2, 1970, applicant informed the Commission it had initiated a main flushing program at nine locations to be continued on a biweekly or monthly basis and that flushing points and intervals would be adjusted according to the adequacy of the program. Applicant by Advice Letter No. 21 and by letter dated November 12, 1970 has advised this Commission that it has resolved its service problems in the above-mentioned area by arranging to transfer all of the customers to California Water Service Company. California Water Service has advised this Commission that it will arrange to provide service from one of its higher pressure zones and is prepared to serve the area in accordance with the standards established by this Commission in its General Order No. 103. By letter dated November 12, 1970, applicant also requests authority to file Appendix B rates effective December 15, 1970, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. North Los Altos Water Company is authorized to file the schedule of rates attached to Decision No. 77211 as Appendix B and to make such rates effective on December 15, 1970 or four days after the date of filing, whichever is later.
- 2. If North Los Altos Water Company exercises the authority herein it shall continue a program of flushing mains through at least nine different fire hydrants at least once each month in the six-month period November through April and at least twice each month in the period May through October and keep records thereof until relieved by further order of this Commission.
