SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78069 entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 609) et al., authorized amendment of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 5, 9-B and 19 and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 in connection with certain exception ratings and rules by extending the governing expiration date from December 31, 1970, to June 30 or December 31, 1971. The decision also provided that Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1971, Ninth Revised Page 20 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
