SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 75928, dated July 15, 1969, issued ex parte in this application, authorized the State of California Department of Public Works to alter the existing crossing of State Route 37 at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company, Crossing No. AAB-64.8, in the City of Vallejo, County of Solano.

By Decision No. 75928, automatic protection consisting of two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms was ordered to be installed in connection with the widening of said crossing.

Decision No. 77687 dated September 1, 1970, Supplemental Opinion and Order, apportioned maintenance costs of the improved grade crossing protection, authorized by Decision No. 75928 at Grade Crossing No. AAB-64.8, 50 percent to Southern Pacific Transportation Company and 50 percent to State of California Department of Public Works, in accordance with, and subject to the terms of, the stipulation of the parties and further in accordance with the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Applicant and Southern Pacific Transportation Company
have since executed an agreement providing for additional crossing
signals mounted on cantilever arms as part of the original proposal.

IT IS ORDERED that protection at State Route 37, Crossing No. AAB-64.8, shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented both with automatic gate arms and additional crossing signals mounted on cantilever arms.

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 75928 and 77687 shall remain in full force and effect.
