Complainant sought suspension of proposed community antenna television tariff schedules submitted by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company by Advice Letter No. 9379, filed September 30, 1966.<sup>1/</sup> The proposed tariffs have been periodically suspended by orders issued in Case No. 8557, a suspension and investigation proceeding (Public Utilities Code, sec. 455).

Pacific Telephone, by petition filed November 30, 1970, has requested an order for permanent suspension and withdrawal of tariff sheets in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 129-T filed under Advice Letter No. 10126, the most recent substitute for the original Advice Letter No. 9379. The Commission, by an order issued this day in Case No. 8557, has nullified the rates, rules and special conditions in the tariff

sheets filed under said Advice Letter No. 10126 and has dismissed Case No. 8557. The complaint herein is thus moot.
