## ORDER DENYING REHEARING

Interim Decision No. 78096, dated December 15, 1970, in these proceedings extended to April 30, 1971, several tariff items scheduled to expire December 30, 1970, pending hearing. Included was Item 149 - Small Shipment Service in Minimum Rate Tariff 2. (MRT 2).

Petition for Reconsideration, Rehearing or Revision of Decision No. 78096, filed by California Trucking Association on December 17, 1970, stayed said decision. The petition asks that if Item 149 of MRT 2 is extended beyond December 31, 1970, the rates in said item be increased to include labor cost increases effective January 1, 1971, as reflected in other rate items of MRT 2 pursuant to Decision No. 78030, dated December 8, 1970. Said request appears reasonable. The sought increases in rates are justified, as shown by the evidence adduced in the proceeding leading to Decision No. 78030. The tariff will be amended accordingly; rehearing will not then be required.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Petition For Rehearing of Decision No. 78096, filed by California Trucking Association is denied.

2. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1971, Twenty-Second Revised Page 19-C, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Ordering paragraphs 2 through 8 and 10 and 12 of Decision No. 78030 are incorporated herein by this reference.

4. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order, on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than January 1, 1971; and as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date hereof.
