ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 74188 dated May 28, 1968, in Application No. 50193, William Tanner was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing him to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Tracy Defense Depot and the Sharpe Depot at Lathrop, on the one hand, and the Cities of Modesto, Manteca and Stockton, on the other hand. During the month of October 1968, William Tanner, without appropriate authority, discontinued passenger stage service between the aforementioned points. Since November 5, 1968, William Tanner has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C.

The Commission concludes that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 74188 should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to William Tanner authorizing him to operate as a passenger stage corporation by Decision No. 74188, in Application No. 50193 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of William Tanner are hereby canceled.
