O P I N I O N

David S. Adams, Nancy Adams Bloom, William Osborn Adams,
 and Elizabeth Anne Peabody, copartners doing business as Adams,
 Schwab & Adams, and Fred Joost, copartners doing business as Esparto
 Warehouse Company, request authority to discontinue operations as a
 public utility warehouseman in Esparto, California.

The certificate is prescriptive in nature and was set
 forth in Decision No. 67440 in Application No. 46675.

It is alleged that there is no present demand for appli-
 cants' service as a public utility warehouseman in Esparto; that the
 storage space in the warehouse buildings in Esparto has been used
 solely by Adams, Schwab & Adams, one of the partners in the Esparto
 Warehouse Company copartnership; and that the need for public ware-
 housing in the Esparto area has been satisfied by other available
 warehouse facilities.

After consideration the Commission finds that public con-
 venience and necessity no longer require applicants' service as a
 public utility warehouseman in Esparto, California. A public hear-
 ing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. After the effective date hereof David S. Adams, Nancy Adams Bloom, William Osborn Adams, and Elizabeth Anne Peabody, copartners doing business as Adams, Schwab & Adams, and Fred Joost, copartners doing business as Esparto Warehouse Company, may discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman in Esparto, California.


2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicants shall cancel their tariff presently on file with this Commission covering their public utility warehouse operations in Esparto, California.


3. Concurrent with the filing required by ordering paragraph 2 hereof the operating authority set forth in Decision No. 67440 in Application No. 46675 is hereby revoked.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
