SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 78011 dated December 1, 1970, Superior Vacuum Truck Service, a corporation, was inadvertently granted authority to suspend service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for a period of one year instead of Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach, a corporation.

The operative rights referred to in Decision No. 78011 were granted to Superior Vacuum Truck Service by Decision No. 51454 dated May 10, 1955, in Application No. 36499 and authorize the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in vacuum tank trucks between all points and places in the Counties of Kern, Ventura, Los Angeles and Orange. These operative rights were subsequently transferred to Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach, a corporation, by Decision No. 58738 dated July 14, 1959, in Application No. 41097.

Decision No. 78011 should be amended to grant the requested suspension to Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach, a corporation, instead of Superior Vacuum Truck Service, a corporation.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 78011 dated December 1, 1970, in Application No. 36499 is hereby amended by substituting "Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach" in place and stead of "Superior Vacuum Truck Service" wherever it appears in the decision.

In all other respects Decision No. 78011 shall remain in full force and effect.
