SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 78056, dated December 8, 1970, in the
 entitled proceeding, Applicant, State of California, Department of
 Public Works was authorized to perform alterations to Culver
 Boulevard, Crossing No. BBE-498.2 as follows:

Culver Boulevard Alteration No. BBE-498.2 (formerly No. 6AB-4.51)	Alteration of grade crossing	66 Feet	Four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), one supplemented by automatic gate arms and one supplemented by flashing light units on a cantilever arm and by automatic gate arms.

By letter dated December 18, 1970, applicant has requested that to meet conditions on the site, the following be substituted for the above:

Culver Boulevard Alteration No. BBE-498.2 (formerly No. 6AB-4.51)	Alteration of grade crossing	66 Feet	Four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), two signals at the curbs supplemented by automatic gate arms.

It appearing that such substitution is desirable,

IT IS ORDERED that such change be made.

In all other respects Decision No. 78056 shall remain in full force and effect.
