It appearing that on September 22, 1970, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation which suspended the effective date of "One-Way Radio Paging Communications", Schedule L-2, which provides a new offering of one-way paging service, filed by Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc. under Advice Letter No. 5 until January 24, 1971, and

It further appearing that a decision in the matter could not be rendered by said date of January 24, 1971, and

The Commission having found that the period of suspension of said tariff sheets should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the effective date of "One-Way Radio Paging Communications", Schedule L-2, filed by Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc. under Advice Letter No. 5 is extended to and including July 24, 1971, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

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The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc.
