O R D E R

The City of Anaheim is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Lewis Avenue under the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, in the City of Anaheim, Orange County, at the location and substantially as shown by plan (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-169.5-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 26-D. Walkway areas adjacent to the tracks shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
