ORDER CANCELLING  
ADVICE LETTER NO. 23  
AND DISCONTINUING  
INVESTIGATION

By order dated December 8, 1970, the Commission (1) sus-  
pended to and including March 30, 1971 Advice Letter No. 23 of  
Bakman Water Company by which it seeks to extend its service into  
a contiguous area and (2) instituted an investigation into the public  
convenience and necessity supporting such expansion of Bakman Water  
Company. On December 29, 1970, Bakman Water Company filed a letter  
stating that it desires to withdraw and cancel Advice Letter No. 23,  
and further stating that at such time as Bakman Water Company refiles  
to serve the area, after the subdivider's plans have become more  
definite, it will notify the water districts which protested the filing  
of Advice Letter No. 23, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Advice Letter No. 23 is cancelled.
2. The investigation herein is discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
