ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 76709 dated January 27, 1970, San Francisco Warehouse Company was authorized to suspend warehouse operations. It is requested that the suspension be extended to February 1, 1972, pending further attempt by applicant to find suitable warehouse facilities in Emeryville in which to resume operations.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of service as authorized by Decision No. 76709 is hereby extended to February 1, 1972 and within sixty days after the date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, San Francisco Warehouse Company shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.
