O R D E R

Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Valley View Street in the City of Buena Park, County of Orange, and in the City of Cerritos, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-504.4-C. Construction of the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Width of crossing shall be 104 feet and grades of approach not to exceed one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates. Back lights may be omitted from the signals to be located in the center medians. No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

No train, engine or car shall be operated over the crossing until after the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track, shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Applicant alleges the industry is in need of immediate service in order to avoid expensive delay.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
