In the Matter of the Investigation into the rates, rules, regulations, charges, allowances, and practices of all highway carriers relating to the transportation of any and all commodities between and within all points and places in the State of California (including, but not limited to, transportation for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 15.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78252, entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 611) et al., established revised "holiday" provisions in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in order to reflect current statutory and labor contract provisions concerning "holidays". Said decision also found that comparable amendments should be made in Minimum Rate Tariff 15. The decision further stated that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff 15 should be amended by separate order.

**IT IS ORDERED that:**

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 15 (Appendix B of Decision No. 65072, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 12, 1971, Eighth Revised Page 4 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.



2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 65072, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the ... of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

7. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

8. In all other respects Decision No. 65072, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>DEFINITION OF TECHNICAL TERMS</b></p> <p><b>AIR MILE</b> means a statute mile measured in a straight line without regard to terrain features or differences in elevation.</p> <p><b>BASE OF OPERATIONS</b> means the single point described in the written agreement which shall be a point at which the shipper will regularly tender freight to the carrier or will regularly receive freight from the carrier.</p> <p><b>CARRIER</b> means a radial highway common carrier, a highway contract carrier or a cement contract carrier as defined in the Highway Carriers' Act.</p> <p><b>CARRIER'S EQUIPMENT</b> means any motor truck or other self-propelled highway vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or any combination of such highway vehicles operated as a single unit.</p> <p><b>CHILLED TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE</b> means the service of providing protection against heat and maintaining the commodity at a temperature higher than 32 degrees Fahrenheit.</p> <p><b>DANGEROUS ARTICLES TARIFF</b> means Motor Carriers' Explosives and Dangerous Articles Tariff 14, Cal.P.U.C. 9, of American Trucking Associations, Inc., Agent, including supplements thereto and reissues thereof.</p> <p><b>ESCORT SERVICE</b> means the furnishing of pilot cars or vehicles by a carrier as may be required by any governmental agency to accompany a shipment for highway safety.</p> <p><b>FROZEN TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE</b> means the service of providing protection against heat and maintaining the commodity at a temperature of 32 degrees Fahrenheit or lower.</p> <p><b>GOVERNING CLASSIFICATION</b> means National Motor Freight Classification A-11.</p> <p><b>HOLIDAYS</b> means New Year's Day (January 1), Washington's Birthday (the third Monday in February), Memorial Day (the last Monday in May), Fourth of July, Labor Day (the first Monday in September), Thanksgiving Day, the Day after Thanksgiving, December 24 and Christmas Day (December 25). When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be considered as a holiday.</p> <p><b>PERMIT SHIPMENT</b> means a shipment which because of its width, length, height, weight or size requires special authority from a governmental agency regulating the use of highways, roads or streets for the transportation of such shipment in whole or in part.</p> <p><b>RATE</b> includes charge and also rules governing and the accessorial charges applying in connection therewith.</p> <p><b>TEMPERATURE CONTROL SERVICE</b> means the protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide), by mechanical refrigeration or by release of liquefied gases.</p>	<p>610</p>

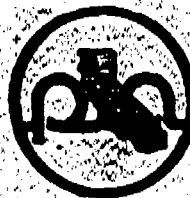
