SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO ESTABLISH SERVICE AND FILE TARIFFS

The Commission by Decision No. 77795, dated October 6, 1970, in the above-entitled proceeding, granted to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a freight forwarder between various points in California.

Paragraph 2(b) of the Commission's order in Decision No. 77795 requires that applicant establish the authorized service and file tariffs in the Commission's office within 120 days after the effective date. By letter dated January 7, 1971, applicant requests an extension of 130 days in which to comply with paragraph 2(b). The request is reasonable and will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 77795, dated October 6, 1970, is amended to provide that applicant shall establish the service authorized by said decision and file tariffs,

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in triplicate, in the Commission's office within
three hundred days of the effective date of Decision No. 77795.
