SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78264 entered today in Case No. 6322 (Order Setting Hearing in Decision No. 74991) et al, established revised provisions governing the transportation of general commodities in the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area. The decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Exception Ratings Tariff 1 should be amended by separate order in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 13, 1971, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not

less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than March 13, 1971; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on nor less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 5. In all other respects Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.

 - SECTION 3 contains table of rates in cents per 100 pounds, based on a percent of a given rate.
