## TRIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By Decision No. 68311, dated December 9, 1964, as modified by Decision No. 72693, dated July 6, 1967, and as further modified by Decision No. 74102, dated May 14, 1968, in the above-entitled matter, the Commission, among other things, authorized Sterling Transit Company, Inc. to issue promissory notes, from time to time, up to an aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$1,000,000 at any one time outstanding, and bearing interest at a rate of not exceeding 7% per annum.

The carrier reports that it has come to an agreement with the lender, Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association, whereby future interest rates will consist of the bank's prime rate plus 3/4 of 1% per annum. In view of constantly changing money rates, petitioner seeks further modification of said Decision No. 68311 so as to authorize the revised basis for interest rates.

After consideration of this Petition for Modification, the Commission finds that the requested change in interest rates would not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the Petition for Modification should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

## THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68311, dated December 9, 1964, as modified, is hereby further modified so as to authorize Sterling Transit Company, Inc. to issue the note, or notes, referred to therein, with interest at the prime rate plus 3/4 of 1% per annum.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 68311, as modified, shall remain in full force and effect, except as further modified by this order.
