## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On September 18, 1970 complainant filed the above entitled complaint, protesting the "automated interconnected mobile telephone service" tariff sheets filed by defendant under cover of its Advice Letter No. 22. Thereafter, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation of said tariff sheets which was docketed as Case No. 9128.

A prehearing conference in Case No. 9128 was held before Examiner Gillanders in Los Angeles on October 20, 1970.

On October 22, 1970 Allied Telephone Companies Association (Allied) filed a petition to intervene in the above two matters.

Following a discussion of the issues at the prehearing conference, complainant met with representatives of defendant and considered the matter further.

By letter dated November 13, 1970, complainant withdrew its objections to the "automated interconnected mobile telephone service" tariff sheets filed by defendant and requested that Case No. 9123 be dismissed.

By letter dated November 17, 1970, Allied stated that it "is of the opinion that the disposition of this matter by dismissal, as proposed by Pomona, is in the public interest. Accordingly, Allied respectfully requests either permission to withdraw its petition to intervene or, in the alternative, that said petition be denied."

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The petition of Allied Telephone Companies Association to intervene is hereby denied.
