ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 75325, entered on February 18, 1969, authorized the City of Visalia to construct a crossing at grade over the Southern Pacific Company's tracks at Bridge Street in Visalia (Crossing No. BAC 253.15). The order is contingent upon Visalia securing an appropriate order of condemnation with respect to certain property adjacent to the crossing. The authority granted in Decision No. 75325 is for a period of two years and is about to expire.


Visalia has filed a petition requesting an extension of the authority granted in Decision No. 75325. The petition indicates that a condemnation action was filed in the Superior Court, that a pretrial hearing has been set for April 8, 1971 and that the probable trial date for the action is sometime in December of 1971. In the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion that the authority granted in Decision No. 75325 should be extended.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 10 of Decision No. 75325 is hereby amended to provide that the authority granted in said decision shall, if not utilized, expire on March 1, 1973.
