ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Zephyr. Street in the City of Hayward, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-27.01-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. It appears that immediate construction of this

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track is essential to avoid delay to street construction now in progress.
