## SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM ORDER

Applicant by letter of February 25, 1971, requests that the time limit specified in the Supplemental Interim Order, Decision 76507, be extended from February 1, 1971 to July 1, 1971 as the work contemplated under Application 50790 has not been completed.
