SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM ORDER

Decision No. 76507, dated December 2, 1969, in Application 50790 authorized the State of California, Department of Public Works to construct the Garfield Lead for temporary use of Southern Pacific Company at grade across the Stockton Belt Line track which is jointly used by Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company in the City of Stockton, County of San Joaquin, in accordance with the Second Petition for Order Allowing Operations Under Temporary Conditions (Rail over Rail), dated November 6, 1969 in Application 50790, dated December 31, 1968.




