SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum:Rate Tariff 7 (MRT 7) names minimum rates and rules for the transportation of property in dump truck equipment between points in the State of California by radial highway common carriers, highway contract carriers and dump truck carriers.

It has come to the Commission's attention that certain rates in Items 138, 148 and 150 of MRT 7 for the transportation of property in excess of 100 miles are inconsistent with the other rates in the tariff for like distances. These rates are constructed by combining the 100-mile rate with the rate for "each 5 miles" that property is transported in excess of 100 miles. The other rates in the tariff for transportation of property in excess of 100 miles are similarly constructed but the additional rate for the excess mileage is for "each 5 miles or fraction thereof."

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the aforementioned inconsistency should be rectified by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff 7 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix A of Decision No. 32566, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective May 1, 1971, the revised pages attached hereto, and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.
- 2. In all other respects, Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
