SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 75988 dated August 5, 1969, Shippers
 Express Company^{1/} (Shippers) was authorized to acquire the certificated
 authority of Encinal Terminals. On November 23, 1970, Shippers
 adopted the tariffs of Encinal (Encinal). As the result of incon-
 sistencies and technical problems arising with the adoption of the
 Encinal tariffs, Shippers requests authority to apply its own tariff
 and to cancel the Encinal tariff with certain specified exceptions.

On February 9, 1971, Shippers Express Company filed
 Application No. 52439 wherein it requested that its certificated
 authority be amended by excluding therefrom the transportation of
 certain commodities. Said application will be disposed of by
 restating applicant's operating authority. In filing a tariff in
 compliance with said order, applicant may incorporate the modifica-
 tions requested herein and insofar as increases are involved the
 Commission finds that said increases are justified.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Shippers Encinal Express, Inc. is hereby authorized to make the tariff changes herein proposed and may incorporate said changes in the tariff to be filed with the Commission in compliance with Decision No. 78460 in Application No. 52439.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
