THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Lee Way Motor Freight of California, Inc. (formerly known as M & R Leasing, Inc.) is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. The carrier was recently merged into Lee Way Motor Freight, Inc. pursuant to authority issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission in Docket No. MC-F-11031. Mr. Richard H. Champlin, General Counsel, for Lee Way Motor Freight, Inc., has submitted to this Commission a copy of the order issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission authorizing the merger. Also, Mr. Champlin has submitted a copy of a Certificate of Qualification issued to Lee Way Motor Freight, Inc. by the Secretary of State of the State of California. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:





2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective  
date hereof, and on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission  
and to the public, Lee Way Motor Freight, Inc. shall amend its  
tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4  
of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the  
date hereof.
