SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 76679, dated January 20, 1970, provides that after the satisfactory planning and installation of facilities in the amounts contemplated in the 1970 rate base, and the filing by applicant of satisfactory plans and scheduling for facilities in the amounts included in 1971 rate base, the Commission may, by supplemental order, authorize the filing of the revised rate schedule attached thereon as Appendix B.

An engineering survey and report prepared by a consulting engineer showing system improvements needed to provide adequate service was filed with this Commission during the year 1970. Mains to improve the water supply to several customers located at higher elevations and two new chlorinators together with appropriate piping, valving and structure were installed by the utility during the same year. The amounts expended by the utility for the above planning and installation of facilities were \$11,121 compared to \$10,500 as contemplated in the 1970 rate base.

By letter received December 21, 1970, the utility has submitted its plan and scheduling of facilities installation that are included in its 1971 rate base. The inclusions cover the relocations

of the water intake and a portion of the pipeline now under the lake. The estimated cost of these improvements is \$20,000 compared to \$12,200 as contemplated in the 1971 rate base.

Compliance with the provisions contained in the above decision having been established by the Commission's staff, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Bass Lake Water Company is authorized to file the revised set of rates attached to Decision No. 76679 as Appendix B. Such filing shall comply with General Order No. 96-A. The effective date of the revised schedule shall be four days after the date of filing. The revised schedule shall apply only to service rendered on and after the date thereof.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
