ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Evidence relative to the complaint was heard in Los Angeles before Examiner Rogers on February 11, 1971, and continued for hearing in Los Angeles on March 3, 1971. At the hearing on March 3, 1971, the parties entered into a stipulation, all parties indicating their acquiescence therein, as follows:

- (1) Tobin to provide Solemint a tank site at 2,000 feet elevation, hereinafter termed Tank Site No. 1, by June 30, 1971. Tobin will apply to Los Angeles County Planning Commission for appropriate County approval of Tank Site No. 1. Solemint to

furnish Tobin necessary information to meet legal requirements of Planning Commission in obtaining its approval.

(2) Tobin to build at its expense a 12-inch line between Tank Site No. 1 and Solemint's line on Placerita Canyon Road no later than December 31, 1972.

(3) Solemint to construct at its expense a 400,000-gallon storage tank on Tank Site No. 1 concurrently with Tobin's installation of a 12-inch line as per paragraph 2.

(4) Solemint to construct a 500,000-gallon storage tank at its expense at a site, hereinafter termed Tank Site No. 2, which is presently graded and approximately 1,100 feet south of the eastern terminus of existing 12-inch main on Placerita Canyon Road to be completed and connected to the existing 12-inch main on Placerita Canyon Road no later than April 1, 1971.

(5) The existing 8-inch main installed in Running Horse Road will be acceptable to Tobin, Solemint and Disney in lieu of existing 12-inch main provided for in the plans and specifications if the system passes the fire flow requirements and tests of the County of Los Angeles and if the change in the plans, that is, from 12-inch mains to 8-inch mains, is accepted by the County of Los Angeles.

(6) Tobin will provide an easement from Tank Site No. 1 to the Disney property via a mutually acceptable route between Tobin and Disney on or before December 31, 1972.

(7) Solemint to start connection of on-site services in Tract No. 25965 immediately and continue such connections with reasonable dispatch. However, in the event the 8-inch on-site main in said tract is not accepted by Los Angeles County, Tobin shall immediately, at its expense, make such changes, modifications, or additions to the on-site facility as may be required to secure the acceptance of such facility by Los Angeles County.

(8) Solemint to furnish Tobin all information, including design and specifications of proposed changed tank and Tank Site No. 2, and existing 12-inch main along Placerita Canyon Road as may be reasonably required by Tobin to obtain appropriate approval of Los Angeles County to changes and plans and bond requirements.

(9) Complaint in Case No. 9171 may be dismissed.

Pursuant to said stipulation,

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint is dismissed.
