O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 73925, dated April 2, 1968, in Application No. 50053, Flour, Inc. was authorized to suspend service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of vegetable oil shortening, salad oil, cooking oil, margarine, lard substitutes, lard compounds, monoglycerides, canned meats, canned goods and grain feed, between Vernon, on the one hand, and all points and places in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Riverside and San Bernardino, on the other hand, for a period of one year ending April 23, 1969. By Decision No. 75571, dated April 15, 1969, in Application No. 50953 the suspension was extended to April 22, 1970. By Decision No. 76974, dated March 24, 1970, in Application No. 51714, the suspension was extended to April 22, 1971. Applicant now requests that said commodities be deleted from its operating authority.

It is alleged that Swift & Company is the only customer served by applicant with reason to ship such commodities.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested authority would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 56591 is hereby amended by substituting First Revised Pages 3 and 4, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, in place of Original Pages 3, 4 and 5.

2. Applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted, said amendment to become effective on April 22, 1971, on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
