In the matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial spur track in, upon and across Alondra Boulevard in the City of Santa Fe Springs, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Application No. 52509 (Filed March 19, 1971)

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Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Alondra Boulevard in the City of Santa Fe Springs, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BK-501.7. Construction of the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Width of crossing shall be 84 feet and grades of approach not to exceed one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates. Backlights may be omitted from the signals to be located in the center medians. No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense of the crossing.

No train, engine or car shall be operated over the crossing until after the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

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Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track, shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
