SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78586, entered today in Case No.
7858 (Petition for Modification No. 93) et al., established a revised
exception rating for egg case or egg carrier filler flats, as
described in Item 60360-A of National Motor Freight Classification
A-11, in Minimum Rate Tariff 19. The decision also provided said
tariff should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of
tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363,
as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become
effective May 29, 1971, the revised pages attached hereto
and made a part hereof by this reference, said pages being specifi-
cally identified as:

Twenty-third Revised Page 3
Sixteenth Revised Page 26

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers
as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the
effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier

than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than May 29, 1971; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
