## REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Farmers Grain and Milling Company (Farmers Grain), a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at 2416-2426 Hunter Street, Los Angeles.

Mr. Herschel B. Green, attorney for Farmers Grain, has informed the Commission by letter that the two growers, which had been storing beans in the warehouse, made arrangements for storage facilities at other public warehouses in 1968 and that no public warehouse operations have been conducted at this location since that date. Mr. Green states that the facilities are currently leased to an industrial tenant and requests that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Farmers Grain and Milling Company, a corporation, for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at 2416-2426 Hunter Street, Los Angeles, is hereby revoked.
- 2. The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Farmers Grain and Milling Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Herschel B. Green, Suite 1218, The Travelers Building, 3600 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90005.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
