SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Falcon Freight, a California corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission in Decision No. 65886 dated August 20, 1963 in Application No. 45607 as amended by Decision No. 68061 dated October 20, 1964. The carrier was recently merged into Silver Fleet, Inc., a California corporation. Applicant has submitted a certified copy of a Certificate of Ownership that has been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of California. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Decision No. 65886 dated August 20, 1963 in Application No. 45607, as amended by Decision No. 68061 dated October 20, 1964, is further amended by substituting "Silver Fleet, Inc." in place and stead of "Falcon Freight."


2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Silver Fleet, Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
