ORDER REVOKING PASSENGER AIR CARRIER CERTIFICATE

By Decision No. 75373 dated February 25, 1969, in Application No. 50391, California Sierra was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger air carrier between Long Beach and Mammoth Lakes, San Francisco and Mammoth Lakes, Long Beach and Bishop Airports and San Francisco and Bishop Airports.

Applicant has requested and received four orders extending time (Decisions Nos. 75736, 76351, 76722 and the most recent Decision No. 77309, dated June 3, 1970) within which to commence service and to file tariffs and timetables. The last of these authorities expired on January 1, 1971.

California Sierra has never exercised the authority granted by Decision No. 75373. Currently, there is no request before the Commission from the carrier for a further extension of time.

It appears and the Commission finds that the non-exercise of such rights constitutes good cause for the revocation of the aforesaid certificate. The Commission concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger air carrier rights created by Decision No. 75373 in Application No. 50391 are revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of California Sierra are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to California Sierra Corp., 3450 East Spring Street, Suite 212, Long Beach, California 90806, last known address as shown in Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the above mailing to California Sierra unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
