THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern California Gas Company (successor to Southern Counties Gas Company of California), on April 9, 1971, filed its Third Supplemental Application herein, asking that the Commission reopen Application No. 43383 to modify Decision No. 73488 by extending the deviation authorized therein. A public hearing is not necessary herein.

IT IS ORDERED that the ordering paragraph of Decision No. 73488 is amended to read as follows:

"2. Southern California Gas Company is authorized to provide interruptible gas service under Schedule No. G-51 to the sodium component test installation of North American Rockwell Corporation's Atomics International Division without requiring adequate standby fuel and equipment."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract, dated December 18, 1970, and set forth in Exhibit A attached to the Third Supplemental Application, shall become effective as of this date.
