ORDER OF MODIFICATION

Decision No. 78112, dated December 22, 1970, in
Application No. 52137, authorized Swift Transportation Company, a
corporation, to purchase a public utility warehouse operating
authority and to operate a warehouse in Gardena, California.

On April 15, 1971 the applicant advised by letter that its warehouse
is in Los Angeles County, not Gardena; although the address of
the warehouse is 14719 S. San Pedro Street, Gardena, California
90247. Applicant requests that its operating authority be amended
to show the correct location of its warehouse.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Appendix A of Decision No. 78112 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 1.
