ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Donald J. French and Jean P. French, doing business as West Coast Van & Storage, possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Vacaville.

Donald J. French, Owner-Manager of West Coast Van & Storage, has informed the Commission by letter that the warehouse facilities have not been used by the public for more than six years and requests that the operative right be canceled.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the prescriptive operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and that the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.
