necessity granted to Applegate Drayage Company by
Decision No. 77852 dated October 20, 1970, in Application No. 52123 and to McKay Trucking Company by
Decision No. 78034 dated December 18, 1970, in
Application No. 52219, which certificates are
revoked effective concurrently with the effective
date of the tariff filings required by paragraph 3
hereof."

2. Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 78531 is rescinded.
